- Authors will need to finalize their papers and send it back to research@asiacentre.org by 13 November 2020
- Revised papers not received by 13 November 2020 will not be included in the Conference Proceedings
- The Editors aim to finalize the compilation and publish the Conference Proceedings by 14 December 2020
- Authors should follow the publication template below: Paper Length: 5,000 - 6,000 words Format: 1.5 Spacing, 12-point Font Size, Times New Roman, Referencing Style: Harvard
- The role of the Authors is to ensure their papers meet the submission criteria, follow the publication template and are adequately proofed for publication as papers will be published as received.
- The role of the Editors is to coordinate the review and feedback process, ensure timely compilation and publication of the proceedings.
