Procedures

- Participants who want their papers to be included in the Conference Proceedings need to submit their full papers by 15 August 2022 to research@asiacentre.org
- After the Conference, the papers will be reviewed and feedback sent to the authors by 2 September 2022.
- Authors will need to finalize their papers and send it back to <u>research@asiacentre.org</u> by 30 September 2022.
- Revised papers not received by 30 September 2022 will not be included in the Conference Proceedings
- The Editors aim to finalize the compilation and publish the Conference Proceedings by 4 November 2022.
- Authors should follow the publication template: Paper Length; 5,000 6,000 words; Format: 1.5 Spacing, 12-point Font Size, Times New Roman, Referencing Style: Harvard
- The role of the Authors is to ensure their papers meet the submission criteria, follow the publication template and are adequately proofed for publication as papers will be published as received.
- The role of the Editors is to coordinate the review and feedback progress, ensure timely compilation and publication of the proceedings.
